#### INTRODUCTION

#### 1.1 About ClonerAlliance Box Pro Pocket

The ClonerAlliance Box Pro Pocket is a portable, standalone video recorder that enables you to capture high-definition videos without needing a PC. It supports a wide range of video input sources such as HDMI, AV, VGA, and YPbPr, allowing you to digitize and preserve videos from modern and legacy devices alike.

#### **Key Features:**

- Compact design with a built-in 3.0-inch LCD screen.
- Standalone operation—no PC required.
- Battery-powered for portability.
- Record up to 1080p @ 60fps.
- Supports USB, TF Card, and external hard drive storage.






# 2.2 Explanation of Buttons, Ports and Remote Control



- 1. Power socket of 12V/1A
- 2. To PC: Connect the USB-A to Micro-B Cable between PC and ClonerAlliance Box Pro Pocket for recording videos to PC.
- 3. OUT: Connect an HDMI cable between ClonerAlliance Box Pro Pocket and TV.
- 4. AUDIO OUT: Connect audio outputs device.


- 5. MIC: Connect Microphone inputs.
- 6. AUDIO IN: Connect audio inputs for VGA signals.
- 7. IN: Connect an HDMI Cable between the video player and ClonerAlliance Box Pro Pocket.
- 8. MMI: MMI input(AV, VGA, YPbPr) port. Please don't connect HDMI device.

- Switch input sources
- Press it to turn on. Press and hold it for 8 seconds to turn off the unit.
- Take a snapshot
- Delete recorded files
- Show the menu to change settings
- Backward button

- Playback recorded files
- Start/Stop recording
- Make selectios
- Fast-forward and fast-backward
- OK Confirm button or Go fullscreen while playing back files




- 9. TF: Insert TF Card.
- 10. USB: Insert a USB flash drive or mobile hard disk and record videos to this storage medium.



- **REC** Start recording.
- Stop recording.
- Select HDMI as the input signal.
- Select VGA as the input signal.
- Select YPbPr as the input signal.
- Select AV as the input signal.
- Mute the HDMI.
- Switch to the aspect ratio of 4:3.
- Switch to the aspect ratio of 16:9.
- Microphone mute.
- Show information.
- Capture an image.
- Adjust the volume of the source video.
- ▲ ▼ Adjust the volume of MIC input.
- Show the main menu.
- Back to the previous interface.
- Set the system time by year/month/day/hour/minute/second.
- Play back the contents in the USB storage device.
- Set the recording frequency. Starting time and recording time. Then videos will be recorded automatically according to your settings.
  - Back to the previous page.
  - Play(full screen) or stop playing.
  - Go to the next page.
- Fast backward.
- Delete the selected Video.
- Fast forward.
- Turn down the volume of speaker.
- Turn up the volume of speaker.
- Mute the speaker.

Tips: The remote control is powered by 2 AAA batteries which are not included and need to be purchased independently.

# **2.4 First-Time Setup Instructions**

Follow these steps to set up your ClonerAlliance Box Pro Pocket:

- 1. Charge the Battery: Connect the Type-C charging cable to charge the NP-F550 battery fully before first use.
- 2. Connect the Video Source: Use an HDMI or MMI cable to connect the device to your video source.
- 3. **Insert Storage**: Insert a USB drive or TF card to store recorded videos. The storage device inserted first has higher priority.
- 4. **Power On**: Connect the power adapter to the DC 12V input on the device or install the battery, it will power up automatically. The built-in screen will display the input video.

**Tip:** Ensure your storage device is formatted in FAT32, exFAT, or NTFS for optimal performance.


#### **POWER OPTIONS**

### 3.1 Using the NP-F550 Battery

The NP-F550 battery provides portable power for the ClonerAlliance Box Pro Pocket, making it ideal for mobile recording.

To use the battery:

- 1. **Install the Battery**: Align the battery with the slot on the back of the device and slide it into place until it clicks.
- 2. Check Battery Charge: Press the power button briefly to check the battery level.
- 3. Remove the Battery: Slide the battery out when not in use or for charging.




# 3.2 Charging the Battery

To charge the NP-F550 battery:

- 1. **Connect the Charger**: Plug the Type-C charging cable into the charging port on the battery.
- 2. Connect to Power: Plug the other end of the cable into a USB power source or a wall adapter.
- 3. **Charging Indicator**: The charging light will indicate when the battery is charging (typically red) and will turn green when fully charged.

**Note:** A full charge provides up to 2.5 hours of continuous recording.



# 3.3 Using the Power Adapter

To power the device directly:

- 1. Plug the Adapter In: Connect the power adapter to the DC 12V input on the device.
- 2. Connect to Power: Plug the adapter into a wall socket.
- 3. Power On: The device will power on automatically or you can manually turn it on using the power button.

**Tip:** You can use the power adapter while the NP-F550 battery is installed to ensure continuous power without interruption.

# 3.4 Power Indicators and Battery Status

The ClonerAlliance Box Pro Pocket uses LED indicators to display power and battery status:

- Battery Status: The screen will display a percentage showing the remaining charge.
- Power LED: Check the power indicators on the back of the battery to confirm the battery status.
- Full battery: 4 segments
- Low battery: 1 segment, indicating the need for charging.




#### SETTING UP CLONERALLIANCE BOX PRO POCKET

### 4.1 Connecting HDMI

To connect an HDMI source to the ClonerAlliance Box Pro Pocket:


- 1. Use the HDMI Cable: Connect one end to the HDMI IN port on the device.
- 2. Connect to Your Source: Plug the other end into your HDMI-compatible device (e.g., Blu-ray player, gaming console).
- 3. Switch Input: Use the Source Selection button to switch to HDMI mode if needed.



# **4.2 Connecting AV (Composite)**

To connect an AV composite video source (such as older camcorders):


- 1. Use the MMI Cable: Plug the MMI cable into the MMI IN port on the device.
- 2. **Connect to Source**: Attach the RCA connectors to your video source's AV output (yellow for video, red/white for audio).
- 3. Switch Input: Press the Source Selection button to switch to AV mode.



### 4.3 Connecting VGA

To connect a VGA video source:


- 1. Use the MMI Cable: Plug the VGA end of the MMI cable into the MMI IN port on the device.
- 2. Connect to Source: Connect the other end to your VGA output device (e.g., a laptop).
- 3. Switch Input: Press the Source Selection button or remote to switch to VGA mode.



### **4.4 Connecting YPbPr (Component)**

To connect a YPbPr component video source:

- 1. Use the MMI Cable: Connect the three component video cables (green, blue, red) to the MMI IN port.
- 2. Connect to Source: Attach the audio connectors (red/white) to your source's audio output.
- 3. Switch Input: Press the Source Selection button to switch to YPbPr mode.




# 4.5 Connecting External Storage (USB, TF Card)

To save recordings, connect a USB or TF card as external storage:

- 1. USB: Insert a USB flash drive or external hard drive into the USB port.
- 2. TF Card: Insert a TF card into the TF Card Slot on the side.
- 3. Check Storage Status: The device will display the available storage on the screen.

**Tip:** Use FAT32, exFAT, or NTFS file systems for compatibility. The storage device inserted first has higher priority.



### 4.6 Connecting to a TV or External Display


To view video on an external display while recording:

- 1. **OUT**: Connect an HDMI cable to the **OUT** port.
- 2. Connect to TV or monitor: Plug the other end into your TV or monitor.
- 3. **Display**: The device will automatically display the video signal on the external TV or monitor.

# 4.7 Using HDMI Passthrough for Simultaneous Viewing

The **HDMI Passthrough** feature allows you to record and simultaneously view the video signal on your TV or monitor:

- 1. Connect HDMI IN: Plug your HDMI source into the IN port.
- 2. Connect HDMI OUT: Connect your TV to the OUT port.
- 3. **Start Recording**: Press the **REC** button to begin recording while watching the video on the TV.



#### RECORDING AND PLAYBACK

### 5.1 How to Start/Stop Recording

To start or stop recording on the ClonerAlliance Box Pro Pocket:

- 1. **Prepare Video Source**: Ensure your video source is connected properly.
- 2. **Insert Storage**: Connect a USB drive or TF card to save the recordings. The storage device inserted first has higher priority.
- 3. Press REC: Press the REC button on the device or remote to start recording.
- 4. **Stop Recording**: Press **REC** again to stop and save the recording.

### 5.2 Recording Video to USB/TF Card

The ClonerAlliance Box Pro Pocket records video directly to external storage. Follow these steps:

- 1. **Insert Storage**: Connect a USB flash drive or insert a TF card into the respective port. The storage device inserted first has higher priority.
- 2. Check Storage Capacity: Ensure there is enough space on your storage device.
- 3. Start Recording: Press the REC button to start recording. The video will be saved as MP4 files.
- 4. **Stop Recording**: Press the **REC** button again to save the file.

**Note:** The device supports file systems such as FAT32, exFAT, and NTFS for storing recordings.

# **5.3 Supported Video Formats and Resolutions**

The ClonerAlliance Box Pro Pocket supports various video formats and resolutions for recording:

- Video Format: MP4 (H.264 compression)
- Audio Format: AAC
- Supported Recording Resolutions:
  - 1920x1080
  - 1280x1024
  - 1280x720
  - 1024x768

Please ensure your storage device has sufficient capacity to store high-definition recordings.

### 5.4 Playback on the Built-In LCD Screen

The Cloner Alliance Box Pro Pocket has a built-in 3-inch LCD screen for instant playback:

- 1. Press the Playback Button: On the device or remote, press the Playback button.
- 2. Select a File: Use the arrow keys on the remote or device to navigate the recorded files.
- 3. Play the Video: Press OK to start playback on the LCD screen.

**Tip:** You can view recorded files without connecting the device to an external display.




# 5.5 Playback on a Connected TV/Monitor

To playback recorded files on an external TV or monitor:

1. Connect to TV: Plug an HDMI cable from the OUT port to your TV or monitor.

- 2. Press Playback: Use the remote or device to select the Playback option.
- 3. Select a File: Use the arrow keys to select the file you want to view.
- 4. Start Playback: Press OK to view the video on your connected display.



### 5.6 Playback from USB/TF Card on a PC

To playback your recordings on a PC:

- 1. Remove Storage: Safely remove the USB drive or TF card from the device.
- 2. Connect to PC: Insert the USB or TF card into your PC.
- 3. Locate Files: Open the storage device on your PC and navigate to the "video" folder.
- 4. Play Files: Use any media player (e.g., VLC) to play the MP4 video files.

**Tip:** Ensure your USB or TF card is formatted in a compatible file system (FAT32, NTFS, exFAT).

#### **ADVANCED FEATURES**

### **6.1 Scheduled Recording:**

The ClonerAlliance Box Pro Pocket allows you to schedule recordings:

- 1. **Press the Schedule Button**: On the remote, press the **Schedule** button.
- 2. **Set the Time**: Use the arrow keys to set the start and stop times for your recording.
- 3. Choose Recurrence: Select whether the recording should occur once or repeat daily.
- 4. Confirm Settings: Press OK to save your schedule.

**Tip:** Make sure the device is powered on and connected to the video source during the scheduled recording period.



# **6.2 Snapshot and Screenshot Features**

The **Snapshot** feature allows you to take still images from your video source at any time:

1. **Press Snapshot**: On the remote or device, press the **Snapshot** button.

- 2. **Save to Storage**: The image will be saved as a JPEG file on your USB or TF card.
- 3. View the Snapshot: You can view snapshots from the Playback menu or transfer them to a PC for further use.

## **6.3 Time Watermark**

To add a time watermark to your recordings:

- 1. Access Settings: Press Menu and navigate to System Settings.
- 2. Enable Time Watermark: Toggle the option to add a timestamp to all recordings.


**Tip:** Time watermarks are useful for organizing recordings and tracking when they were made.



# 6.4 Low-Latency Gaming Capture (PS5, Xbox One, Switch)

The ClonerAlliance Box Pro Pocket is designed for ultra-low latency capture, ideal for gaming on consoles such as PS5, Xbox One, and Nintendo Switch.

- 1. Connect Console via HDMI: Plug your console's HDMI output into the device's IN port.
- 2. Use HDMI Passthrough: Connect the OUT port to your monitor or TV for live gameplay while recording.
- 3. **Start Recording**: Press **REC** to capture gameplay with a latency under 100ms.



## **AUDIO SETTINGS AND FEATURES**

## 7.1 Adjusting HDMI Audio Output

To adjust the HDMI audio settings on the ClonerAlliance Box Pro Pocket:

- 1. **Press Menu**: Press the home button on ClonerAlliance Box Pro Pocket or on the remote to navigate to setup menu.
- 2. Navigate to Audio Settings: Enter the Audio settings, and select the HDMI Volume option.
- 3. Adjust the Volume: Use the arrow keys to increase or decrease the HDMI audio output level.

**Tip:** Ensure your video source's audio is set to PCM or Stereo for compatibility.



# 7.2 Using the Mic Input for Commentary

The **Mic** input allows you to add voice commentary to your recordings:

1. **Plug in the Microphone**: Insert a microphone into the **Mic** port (3.5mm jack).

- 2. Adjust Mic Volume: Open the audio settings from the menu and adjust the Mic Volume.
- 3. **Record Commentary**: Start recording, and your voice will be mixed with the video's audio.



## 7.3 Audio Mixing

The ClonerAlliance Box Pro Pocket allows mixing and monitoring audio from external line in sources with the recorded video:

- 1. Connect Audio Source: Plug your external audio source into the Line-In port.
- 2. Line-Out to Speakers: Use the Line-Out port to connect external speakers or headphones for monitoring.
- 3. Enable Line Out Mixed: In the audio settings, enable Line out mixed to monitor the sound of line in and microphone.
- 4. **Audio Mixing**: Once line in sources and microphone are connected, it will automatically combine the mixed audio with the recorded videos.

## 7.4 Built-In Speaker and Volume Adjustment

The ClonerAlliance Box Pro Pocket has a built-in speaker for video playback:

1. Playback a Video: Select a recorded file and press OK to start playback.

#### **ClonerAlliance Box Pro Pocket User Manual**

- 2. Adjust Volume: Use the volume buttons on the remote to increase or decrease the speaker volume.
- 3. **Mute**: Press the **Mute** button on the remote if needed.

Note: The built-in speaker is primarily for monitoring and may not provide full audio fidelity.

## **VIDEO SETTINGS AND CUSTOMIZATION**

# **8.1 Adjusting Video Resolution**

To change the recording resolution:

- 1. Press Menu: Open the main menu.
- 2. Navigate to Video Settings: Select Record Resolution.
- 3. Choose Resolution: Select from available options such as 1920x1080, 1280x1024,1280x720 and 1024x768.

Tip: Higher resolutions require more storage space, so ensure you have adequate capacity.



### **8.2 Bitrate Control**

The ClonerAlliance Box Pro Pocket allows you to adjust the video bitrate for different recording quality levels. A higher bitrate provides better quality but requires more storage space, while a lower bitrate saves space at the cost of quality.

8.2. Bitrate Control 40

#### To adjust the bitrate:

- 1. **Press Menu**: Access the menu using the remote.
- 2. Navigate to Video Settings: Select Bitrate.
- 3. Choose Bitrate: Options include High, Medium, and Low.

Tip: Use High for the best quality, and Low for smaller file sizes when storage is limited.

# 8.3 Adjusting Brightness, Contrast, and Saturation

The ClonerAlliance Box Pro Pocket allows you to customize the video display settings, such as brightness, contrast, and saturation.

#### To adjust these settings:

- 1. **Press Menu**: Open the settings menu.
- 2. Navigate to Image Settings:
  - Brightness: Adjust the brightness level.
  - Contrast: Adjust the contrast for better clarity.
  - Saturation: Modify color saturation for more vivid colors.
- 3. Save Settings: Press OK to apply the changes.



# **8.4 Loop Recording**

Loop recording allows the **ClonerAlliance Box Pro Pocket** to continuously record over the oldest video once the storage device is full.

To enable loop recording:

- 1. Press Menu: Access the settings.
- 2. Navigate to Recording Settings: Select Loop Recording.
- 3. Enable: Toggle the option to On.

**Tip:** Loop recording is useful when recording security footage or when storage space is limited.



# **8.5 Setting File Size Limits**

The ClonerAlliance Box Pro Pocket can limit the maximum size of each recorded file, splitting larger videos into smaller segments for easier management.

To set file size limits:

- 1. **Press Menu**: Open the menu settings.
- 2. Navigate to File Settings: Select File Size.
